BUSINESS MEETING

Pleasant Grove Baptist Church met in regular business meeting with Rev. Justin Randolph presiding. Minutes of the March meeting were read and approved. Organization and department reports were given. Finance report for March was presented. The Sunday School average attendance for March was 147, average contacts were 113 and average attendance for April was 170, average contacts were 118. Justin Randolph gave a pastoral report for April. Diann Ringer reported for the WMU. WMU will continue to collect children's Bibles and storybooks for CHARM. Dan Blevens reported for the Trustees. The trustees have completed the following items in March & April: Pavilion was de-winterized; pavilion kitchen door frame has been replaced; two sticking doors adjusted at the office and sanctuary; door kick stops installed on front doors and closet doors in fellowship hall; tv and two signs installed in the RA room; AC unit under the sanctuary has been repaired; two motion lights switches have been installed in the restroom; laser printer furnished for the SS office; ice machine has had it's 6 month cleaning; new signs for Pastor Justin and the office have been installed. Trevis Gardner reported for the Stewardship Committee. The in-house account will be renamed to the Ministry Support Account, and a policy for using the account has been adopted. Trevis Gardner reported for the Media Committee. Approximately 5534 unique slides to support worship services have been developed and displayed between January 1 and May 18, 2025. The media and IT initiative has been created, and the highlights of the initiative were given.

Old Business: The Trustees' Bus Policy was presented and reviewed for approval. Passed

New Business: Trustee Committee recommended Sonya Christopher for trustee. Passed

Motion to approve response to requests made by Coram Deo, in which two requests were recommended by the Stewardship Committee, Deacons, and Trustees. Passed Motion by Trevis Gardner and a second by Andy Waters to change the dates for the June and July business meeting to the second Sunday of the month. Passed Andy Waters motioned to adjourn.
