

BUSINESS MEETING

Pleasant Grove Baptist Church met in regular business meeting with Brent Bustin presiding. Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved. Organization and department reports were given. Finance reports for December and February were presented. The Sunday School average attendance for December was 132, average contacts were 81. The Sunday School average attendance for February was 154, average contacts were 120. Dan Blevens reported for the Trustees. A commode was rebuilt in the ladies' room, a fan motor in the office heat unit was replaced, 10 lights were replaced in the Fellowship Hall, and two downspouts were re-attached to the building outside of the Fellowship Hall. David and Jud assisted in elevating the seats in the choir loft. The youth minister's office has been cleared out in anticipation of a permanent youth minister. Two new high chairs have been ordered for the Fellowship Hall, and the proposed bus policy is ready for consideration.

New Business: The Trustees recommended a new bus policy. It will be voted on at the next business meeting. David Schultz motioned to adjourn. All in favor.
