Greg Long reported for Discipleship Training. A follow-up class to Don Sunshine's "Make A Difference" event began April 23rd. The class will continue for six weeks. Diann Ringer reported for the WMU. Twenty-Seven Resurrection Baskets were delivered to the Baptist Center. Easter cards have been mailed. The Mother's Day offering will be taken on Mother's Day. WMU will be collecting children's Bibles and children's Christian books to give to CHARM for the month of May. Dan Blevens reported for the Trustees. Kitchen and bathroom at the pavilion have been opened; playground equipment set up; two urinals repaired; fellowship hall trim and doors have been painted; restroom stall latches have been lubricated; light fixtures are being converted to LEDs. Jerri Thompkins reported for the Homebound Ministry. The ministry is just now in the midpoint of the first of two annual rotations for Person of the Week. The ministry continues to thrive, with all cards being sent as scheduled. Three Homebound members had April birthdays and cards have been sent. Easter cards were sent to all Homebound members. Pat Amos reported for Executive Board. A recommendation that was presented at the April Association meeting concerning a one year lease of the Back Country Store building in Townsend to be used as headquarters for the CHARM. Exciting opportunities were explained and the recommendation was unanimously accepted. It was also reported that 240 Resurrection Baskets were distributed through the Baptist Center.
