This month we will be participating in the "Pack a Pack" program sponsored by the Chilhowee Baptist Center. The Baptist Center expects to distribute around 350 backpacks this year. A list of supplies will be distributed to each of the Sunday School classes and listed below.

Backpacks need to be turned in by July 9th. Backpacks for 2nd - 5th grades are the most needed.

Please place backpacks on the table to the left of the Sunday School office door. CBC is also in need of new socks and underwear for children, K-12. They ask that you please do not put the socks and underwear inside the backpacks. They are also receiving calculators this year.

These will be given to the school system and will be distributed to the students who need them.

Thank you for your help in this ministry. Please be in prayer for this ministry and for the clients that receive the backpacks. The primary goal is to share Christ with those that come through the doors and to encourage them in their walk with the Lord.
