Gift Suggestions:

TOYS: Include items that children will immediately embrace such as dolls, toy cars, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, balls, toys that light up and make noise (with extra batteries), etc.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES: pens, pencils and sharpeners, crayons, markers, notebooks, paper, solar calculators, coloring and picture books, etc.

NON-LIQUID HYGIENE ITEMS: toothbrushes, bar soap, combs, washcloths, etc.

ACCESSORIES: t-shirts, socks, hats, sunglasses, hair clips, jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries), etc.

A PERSONAL NOTE: You may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself or your family. If you include your name and address, the child may be able to write back.

DO NOT INCLUDE: Used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives or military figures; chocolate or food; any candy; toothpaste; liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.

ALL lists will be available in the Sunday School classes and the table in the hallway beside the Sunday School office. The next couple of months is a very busy time of the year! The Baptist Center greatly appreciates all of the support from our church.

Please bring in any of the food items listed below:

Instant mashed potatoes or canned diced potatoes; box of stuffing mix; chicken broth (15 oz can); packet of gravy mix; cranberry sauce (14 oz can); fruit cocktail (15 oz cans); 4 lb bag of sugar; easy make Dessert (box cake mix and frosting, cookie mix, or no bake cheesecake); small box of tea bags; bag of coffee

Baby Items:

Baby wipes; baby blankets; baby powder, lotion and shampoo; baby wash; bibs; socks; and small toys.

Items for drawstring bags:
