Business Meeting

Pleasant Grove Baptist Church met in regular business meeting with Rev. Greg Long presiding. Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved. Organization and department reports were given. Finance report for January was presented. The Sunday School average attendance for January was 157, average contacts were 224. Diann Ringer reported for the WMU. Valentine's Day cards were mailed to homebound members. Collection of Resurrection baskets has begun and will continue to March 25th. Bette Wade reported for the Trustees. Paint projects at church will begin soon. A church wide "Spring cleaning" will be scheduled for mid-April. Jerri Thompkins reported for the Homebound Ministry. The 2018 Person of the Week ministry began on Feb. 4th. Valentines cards were sent and Easter cards will go out in March. Due to the passing of Richard Hancox, no cards will be sent out for the week of March 25-31. Please know that all cards that are sent are always appreciated. Pat Amos submitted a report for the Executive Board meeting in January. The meeting was represented by eleven churches, which did not meet the quorum of twelve. Therefore, reports were given with no voting allowed. Work will begin soon on the new building at Camp Tipton. January has been the busiest January in the history of our Baptist Center. Four teams are lined up for a mission trip to Puerta Rico to work with two churches. Rev. Kenny Armstrong will be leading his fourth trip to West Africa. The garden project involves five fenced acres divided into plots for family gardens. Two wells will be required at a cost of \$5,000 per well. Six wells are the goal.
