Pleasant Grove Baptist Church met in regular business meeting with Rev. Greg Long presiding. Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved. Organization and department reports were given. Finance report for March was presented. The Sunday School average attendance for March was 188, average contacts were 235. Greg Long reported for the WMU. Thanks to everyone that has given to Annie Armstrong Offering.

We have received over \$7,500. WMU will purchase boxes cereal for the TBCH. WMU is also still collecting children's Bibles and children's Christian books to give to CHARM. Thank you for your donations. Bette Wade reported for the Trustees. Thank you to the folks that helped with the church spring cleaning. It was a success. Jerri Thompkins reported for the Homebound Ministry. We are now past the halfway mark of the first rotation for sending out the cards, and all cards continue to be sent as scheduled. The ministry has two April birthdays, and cards have been sent. Again, thank you for remembering our homebound with cards. Greg Long reported for Executive Board. The April meeting of the Chilhowee Executive Board reported that the Baptist Center debt has been paid in full. They will celebrate their 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary in 2019. The DOM reported on the West Africa partnership. Four wells with fencing and garden preparation have been completed with \$9,500 donations. A team of three from our Association will join other teams for a trip to Ecuador in July. The WMU Director announced a cereal collection project for the Tennessee Baptist Children's Home for the month of April. Two work groups completed several projects at Camp Tipton. A team of 45 from Queens, NY did several projects at our Spanish church.
