This month we will be participating in the “Pack a Pack” program sponsored by the Chilhowee Baptist Center. The Baptist Center expects to distribute around 350 backpacks this year. A list of supplies will be distributed to each of the Sunday School classes and listed below.

Backpacks need to be turned in by July 8th. Backpacks for 2nd - 5th grades are the most needed.

Please place backpacks on the table to the left of the Sunday School office door. CBC is also in need of new socks and underwear for children, K-12. They ask that you please do not put the socks and underwear inside the backpacks. They are also receiving calculators.

Thank you for your help in this ministry. Please be in prayer for this ministry and for the clients that receive the backpacks. The primary goal is to share Christ with those that come through the doors and to encourage them in their walk with the Lord.

Business Meeting

Pleasant Grove Baptist Church met in regular business meeting with Rev. Greg Long presiding.

Motion by Mary Mueller and 2nd by Ken Johnson to allow Susan Bullen to stand in as acting clerk while Lisa Hill is away on vacation. Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved. Organization and department reports were given. Finance report for May was presented. The Sunday School average attendance for May was 183, average contacts were 166. Camilla Benson reported for the WMU. More than 100 items including children's Bibles and books, crayons and coloring books were donated for CHARM's summer program in Townsend. We are participating in the "Pack a Pack" program for Chilhowee Baptist Center. Backpacks with school supplies will be collected until July 8th. Thank you for your generous support as we help meet needs in our association. Stanley Janeway reported for the Trustees. The lock and door closure project is continuing. A police officer will begin patrolling our parking lot during the 3 1/2 hours of services on Sunday mornings beginning this coming week, June 24th. A donation account will pay for this service thru the end of the fiscal year. A new line item will be added in the budget next year to pay for the service. The cost is \$105 per week.
