BUSINESS MEETING

Pleasant Grove Baptist Church met in regular business meeting with Rev. Greg Long presiding. Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved. Organization and department reports were given. Finance report for June was presented. The Sunday School average attendance for June was 190, average contacts were 210. Diann Ringer reported for the WMU. Thirty-eight

backpacks, several packs of underwear and socks and cleaning supplies, and a \$500 donation from the Happy Helpers Sunday School Class were collected for the Baptist Center. Thank you to everyone for their donations. Also, thank you to the young men that helped load the items in the car. WMU will be receiving the Golden Offering for TN Missions during the month of September. Collection of blankets and sheets for the Baptist Center will begin in September. Bette Wade reported for the Trustees. Trustees are almost finished replacing door locks on the doors. The playground equipment has been washed and preparations are underway for painting and putting in some soft-landing areas. Jerry Thompkins reported for the Homebound Ministry. The ministry has one July birthday and cards will be sent. New schedules for the second rotation will be posted in classrooms and given to individuals by July 22nd. The second rotation will begin July 29th. Our homebound members are always close in heart and in Christian love, and we thank each of you for sending cards. Greg Long reported for Executive Board for Pat Amos. Seventeen churches were represented at the July Associational Executive Board meeting. The Baptist Center reported that 1,504 families were assisted with food during the past three months. Food costs have increased twenty-five percent this year, creating a need for more donations from our churches. Camp Tipton will soon promote a "Child To Camp" fund raiser to help families who cannot afford camp, especially foster children. Seven volunteers from our Association are part of a mission trip to Puerto Rico this week. The backpack give-away will be on Saturday, July 21st.
