The Keep in Touch guest for February is Sam Compton. He is the program manager for all Second Harvest Youth and Senior Programs in the food bank's 18-county service area. Sam and his team have taken the Food for Kids program from its inception in 2003-with one school serving 25 children-to serving more than 12,500 children every week in 280 schools. In addition to his work on behalf of hungry children, Sam has overseen the Senior Outreach program in recent years as well. This effort has grown to serve more than 1,000 seniors through 20 program sites, and he is working to expand the program's reach by utilizing several new distribution models. Sam was born and raised in Knoxville, attended West High School and the University of Tennessee.
