Randy recently retired from a nearly 40-year career as head coach of the Maryville College men's basketball team. He is a member of the Maryville College Class of 1976, and now serves Maryville College as the Athletics Campaign Coordinator.

With 722 career victories, Randy Lambert is one of the most successful NCAA Division III coaches. When he retired he ranked fourth in the country among active head coaches in career victories. Among all-time Division III coaches, Randy is ranked eighth in total victories and 25th across NCAA Division III by winning percentage. He ranks 42nd all-time across all divisions with 722 wins. As a man of faith he will share how that faith has helped him in his life.
