BUSINESS MEETING

Pleasant Grove Baptist Church met in regular business meeting with Pastor Randolph presiding. Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved. Organization

and department reports were given. Finance reports for December 2025 and January 2026 were presented. The Sunday School average attendance for December 2025 was 155, average contacts were 118. Pastor Randolph gave a pastoral report for the past months. Diann Ringer reported for the WMU. Cards were mailed to homebound members. Information for the collection of Resurrection baskets will be in the newsletter. Dan Blevens reported for the Trustees. Trustees have completed the following items in the past two months: two toilets have been repaired; sink valve repaired; security light repaired; blower on heat unit replaced; installed a mop holder in the kitchen closet; replaced the carpet in the fellowship hall; in the process of converting the library into a classroom; concrete pit has been poured for the elevator and the equipment has been ordered; new chairs for the fellowship have been ordered thanks to a donor; replaced light cover in the hall; working to repair leaks in the sanctuary ceiling. We are asking for 5-6 volunteers after the Men's Breakfast to help clean out the outdoor storage at the kitchen and clear out the playground. David Hammonds reported for the Youth. The youth are studying the book of Revelation; several youths attended a basketball game at EMBC to support some youth players; the Valentine's Fundraiser has raised approximately \$2,100 as of Feb. 15th; David met with some of the youth's parents.

Old Business: The updated dissolution presented at the November 2025 business meeting was presented for approval. Passed

New Business: WMU recommended that the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering goal be \$12,000. Passed.

The Constitution and Bylaws Committee presented a revised Constitution to be voted on at the March 2026 business meeting.

Marty Mueller motioned to adjourn. All in favor.
