According to the IRS, you must use offering envelopes to receive a statement of giving from the church for tax purposes. Be sure to discard your 2022 envelopes.

Please do not use 2023 envelopes until the first of the year. If you are currently or are planning on using online giving, you do not need to get a box of offering envelopes.

2022 Contribution Statements

You can receive your 2022 contribution statement by calling the church office (977-1526), turning in the response tear off from the bulletin with your name and phone number, or by going to our website (pgbctn.org) and filling out an online "I Wish" card. The office is only able to give statements for those who used offering envelopes with their name on the envelope.
