- 1 tube toothpaste 6oz. minimum
- 2 toothbrushes (adult)
- 1 Laundry Detergent, 32-50 loads

- 1 All Purpose Spray Cleaner 32 oz.
- 1 can disinfectant spray
- 1 container of disinfectant wipes

BUSINESS MEETING

Pleasant Grove Baptist Church met in regular business meeting with Rev. Greg Long presiding. Minutes of previous meeting were read and approved. Organization and department reports were given. Finance report for January was presented. The Sunday School average attendance for January was 164, average contacts were 120. Diann Ringer reported for the WMU. Cards have been sent to the homebound members. Collection for the resurrection baskets has begun and will continue through March 19th. Dan Blevens reported for the trustees. Leaves were cleaned from the prayer garden, and two worn-out tables were replaced in the RA room. A dead tree in front of the church office has been removed. Several light bulbs have been replaced in the sanctuary, and two light fixtures have been repaired. One heat unit was fixed, and the heat exchanger was discovered to be cracked, which caused the thermal relay to kick out. This unit will be replaced on Tuesday. Lastly, the carbon monoxide detectors have been installed near all heat unit clusters. Greg Long reported for the Homebound Ministry.
