CBC Annual Christmas Celebration

This holiday season, the CBC will be providing Christmas meals for many of their clients. They also will be collecting food and snacks to fill drawstring bags for children. Also, we will be collecting items for baby bags. Now through Wednesday, November 15th, we will collect items to help the CBC. We have four different ways to help:

2. Provide items for the children's drawstring bags:
