<u>It's fast</u> - If you're using an app like Pushpay, you can probably give in a fifth of the time it would take you to write one check.

<u>It's green</u> - You're writing fewer checks, and you're using fewer envelopes.

<u>It's secure</u> - Giving digitally is much more secure than cash or checks.

Your giving schedule is up to you - If you feel the need to give, you can. You don't rely upon our organization or service to give your gift.
