

Finance report for November was presented. The Sunday School average attendance for November was 176, average contacts were 115. Diann Ringer reported for the WMU. Seventy-six shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child have been donated. Thanks to everyone who came to the chili supper. Mike Coulter reported for the Deacons. The ordination service for the four Yoke fellows has been scheduled for January 15, 2025. Dan Blevens reported for the trustees. The following projects have been completed: three heat units were installed, and one AC and heat unit blower were replaced. A broken swing seat was replaced; the soffit was repaired on the west dormer; the pavilion kitchen and bathroom have been winterized; one commode was remodeled; one outside drain was cleaned; bases for the offering boxes have been replaced; the carpet in room 30 and the fellowship hall have been cleaned; leaves around the church have been mulched; office weather head riser and meter that were loose, have been reattached.

Old Business: The 2025 Proposed Church Budget presented at the November Business meeting was approved.

New Business: Motion by Susan Bullen with a 2nd by Mike Morrell to grant request for church letter for Wayne and Lola Taylor to Hillcrest Baptist Church. Passed
