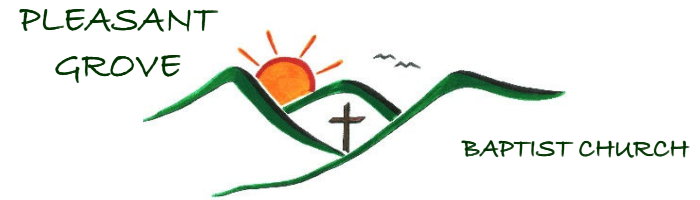
### Aluminum Cans Discontinued

## Highlights of Message From Chilhowee Baptist Association Office

We are faced with unique challenges due to un-foreseen circumstances, but God has a purpose and plan behind the World's chaos which will bring Him glory and honor. Local, State & National entities are reaching out to churches to help meet the needs of their communities. The TBMB, in response to a request from the Center for Disease Control, has asked that Associations stand ready to respond to community needs. These are a few of the areas the Chilhowee Baptist Association is beginning to reach out to in our community. It is our goal to assist local churches in ministering to their communities.

**Action Point 1** – Through the Chilhowee Baptist Center we are working with local churches to provide food box distribution points. Currently, plans are in place for two food distribution points Wednesday, March 25<sup>th</sup> at Mt Carmel Baptist from 10-Noon. And Thursday, March 26 at Bethel Baptist from 10:00 -Noon. In addition, we have a Second Harvest Food truck scheduled for the Walland Community the week of April 6<sup>th</sup>. Distribution most likely will be at Rocky Branch Baptist Church gym. We are looking to have two locations to distribute for the Week of March 30<sup>th</sup> – April 2<sup>nd</sup>.

**Action Point 2** - We are looking to put a delivery system in place to assist those who are self-isolated or elderly who may need delivery of food or pharmacy items.

**Action Point 3** –We are preparing for the possibility of at least two feeding locations to offer hot meals for drive up pick-up and delivery to those shut in. Broadway Baptist and Dotson Memorial have agreed to open up their kitchens to prepare the meals. May our response during time be that of Nehemiah chapter 6 verse 9, *“For they all were trying to make us afraid, saying, ‘Their hands will be weakened in the work, and it will not be done.’ Now therefore, O God, strengthen my hands.”*
