You can receive your 2020 contribution statement by calling the church office (977-1526), turning in an "I Wish" card with your name and phone number, or by going to our website (pgbctn.org) and filling out an online "I Wish" card. The office is only able to give statements for those who used offering envelopes with their name on the envelope. We have no other records of giving without the use of envelopes. Statements will be mailed starting the week of January 18th.

2021 Offering Envelopes

The boxes of 2021 envelopes are available for pick up in the hallway near the foyer. If you used envelopes in 2020, please look for the box with <u>YOUR</u> name on the top. If you were not using envelopes in 2020 but would like to begin using them in 2021, please pick up a box that has <u>NO</u> name on the top and <u>take the lowest number</u> available. <u>According to the IRS, you must use offering envelopes to receive a statement of giving from the church for tax purposes.</u> Be sure to discard your 2020 envelopes.

If you would like to receive envelopes but are unable to attend church, you can call the church office at 977-1526 to arrange pickup of envelopes.
