In October, we will be collecting new blankets for CBC and will start Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes. DiAnne Wilson reported for the Trustees. The following projects have been completed: the AC unit at the office has been repaired, the parking lot has been resealed, and the visitor and handicapped spaces have been relined. A new stove was placed and wired in the kitchen. The old library has been painted, and a baseboard has been installed, converting it into a classroom. Special thanks to Jud, Spencer, Justin, Stanley, and Terry for getting the new stove moved in and installed, and for getting the old stove out. David Hammonds reported for the Youth. The Youth Sunday School class has split into two classes; an average of 23 youth are in Sunday school; September 23rd is Youth Sunday for the youth to teach in Sunday school classes; FCA Field of Faith will be held on the 16th, and we will be participating; a trip is planned for Snowbird in October.
